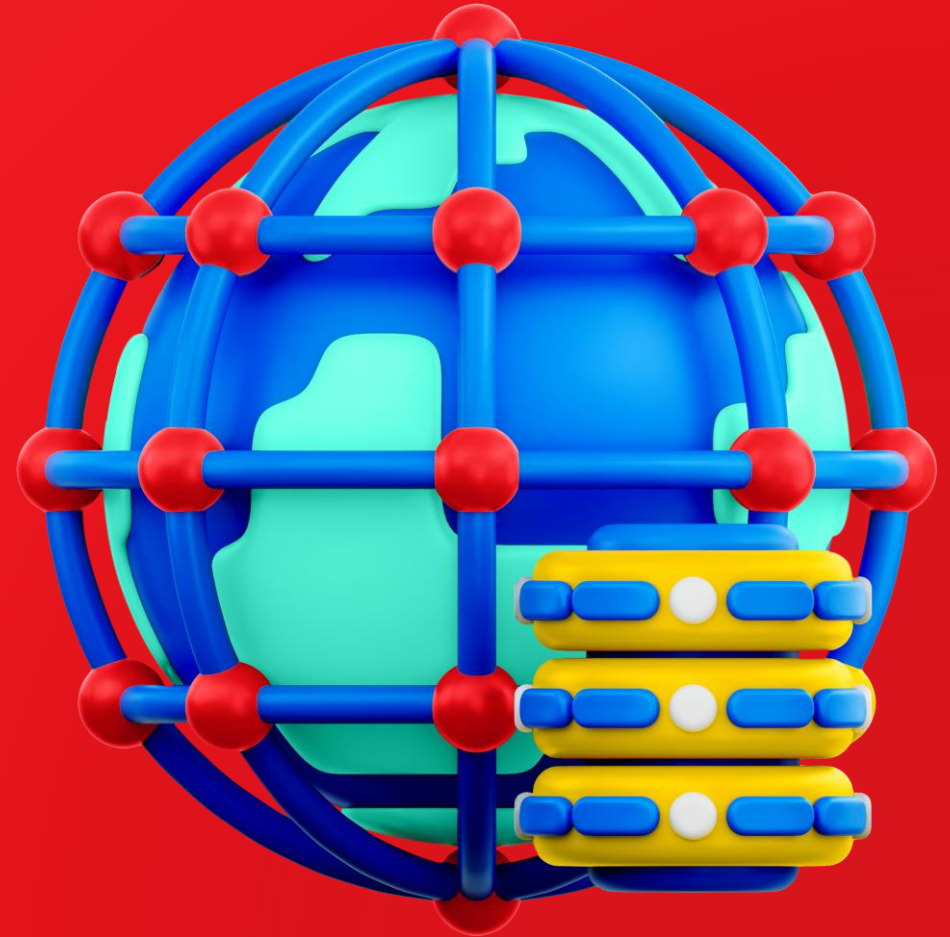

- Aziz holds a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from ESLSCA University

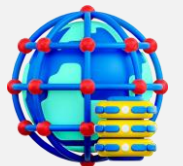


Abdulla Ahmed Al-Zaman

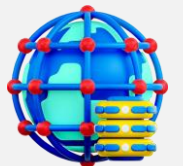
- René Werner was appointed Group Chief Strategy Officer in March 2021 and Acting Chief Consumer Officer since July 2025

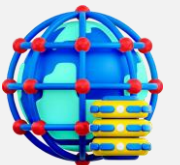
- Sheikh Ali Bin Jabor Al-Thani was appointed Chief Executive Officer of Ooredoo Qatar in January 2023

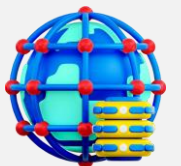
